Whole School Evacuation

As part of our WHS compliance, we conducted an Evacuation Drill last Week. Emergency drills are simply a routine practice to ensure all students and all staff are aware of our emergency procedures, know what to do and where to go! Our procedures are designed to keep students and staff safe while emergency services deal with a real situation, if it was to occur.

In the unlikely event of a real evacuation or lockdown being required, parents will be notified as soon as it is practical to do so. If your child's stay is extended beyond the regular time, you will receive information about the time and place that you can pick up.
